The Brazoria County Health Department Water Laboratory is a nationally accredited (NELAC certified) laboratory for the detection of Total Coliform and *E.Coli* bacteria in drinking water supplies. Coliform, and specifically *E.Coli*, bacteria are commonly found in sewage, which could include other disease producing bacteria.

MISSION STATEMENT

The Brazoria County Water Lab is committed to providing consistent, timely and accurate testing data of known and documented quality to its customers. The laboratory ensures that personnel are free from any commercial, financial and other undue pressures, which might adversely affect the quality of work. All employees are trained annually on ethical principles and procedures surrounding the data generated from lab analyses.

Purpose: To provide testing of Public Drinking Water Supplies for monthly compliance with EPA “Coliform Rule” and also for private domestic water wells with respect to potential harmful bacteria.
