

TRANSITIONAL SHELTERING ASSISTANCE (TSA) NOTIFICATION

- FEMA has granted the state's request for an extension of transitional sheltering assistance for Hurricane Ike.
- Those applicants who have either been found eligible for FEMA's Individuals and Households Program or have not yet received a FEMA inspection of their damaged home are being notified this weekend that they are approved, on a case-by-case basis, to stay in hotels/motels until Oct. 28.
- Applicants who are deemed ineligible for transitional sheltering assistance are being notified that FEMA will not longer pay for their hotel beyond Oct. 28, 2008. These applicants will not be granted a further extension and applicants who choose to remain in hotels the night of Oct. 28 and beyond will do so at their own expense.
