### Notice of Estray

On August 16<sup>th</sup> 2010, this department was notified of an estray, being held at the Wharton Livestock Auction in Wharton, Texas. The estray is described as follows:

One Longhorn/Corriente type bull, unknown age, weighing approximately 700 pounds. Long horns, white mark on face goes up over the top of the head, black on sides of face and nose area. Body is black, white, and red speckled. No other marks or brands noted Bull has an old injury of a broken jaw also. .

No brands could be found on this animal, and a diligent search has turned up no owners. The animal was found in a pasture located on the Southeast corner of the intersection of FM 523 and FM 2004 South of Angleton, Texas.

This animal was listed in Estray Book at the County Clerk's Office, in the Brazoria County Courthouse, Angleton, Texas on August 24<sup>th</sup> 2010, and if no owners are located by September 8<sup>th</sup> 2010, it will be sold at auction at the Wharton Livestock Auction, in Wharton Texas.
