Notice of Estray

On March 3rd 2011 , this department was notified of an estray, being held at a pasture located at 311 County Road 735 Angleton, Texas. The estray is described as follows:

A miniature buckskin stallion, approximately 4 years of age and standing approximately 35 inches high. Horse has a blaze on face, white socks above all four hooves and his mane and tail are flaxen. Horse is in ideal body condition. No other marks or brands noted.

No brands could be found on this animal, and a diligent search has turned up no owners. The animal was found by Deputy James Kennedy of the Brazoria County Sheriff's Office in the middle of FM 521 between CR 32 North and CR 32 South.

This animal was listed in Estray Book at the County Clerk's Office, in the Brazoria County Courthouse, Angleton, Texas on April 5th 2011, and if no owners are located by April 30th 2011, it will be turned over to Blue Bonnet Equine Rescue.
